YMCA Child Care Services

Harris Health partnered with YMCA to offer a reduced rate for childcare to staff. Locations will only be open to children of essential healthcare personnel. A maximum of 45 eligible children will be served at locations across the Houston area.

Cost

- Children, ages 5-12: \$30 per child per day
- Children, ages 3-5: \$40 per child per day
- Infants, ages 12-36 months: \$50 per day

Meals

Each child will receive lunch and an afternoon snack during the day. If the Houston Food Bank or another community partner is unable to provide meals for the day, parents will be responsible for each child.

Extension for Certification Renewals

Life Safety Certifications

Due the pandemic, Harris Health is extending expiration dates by 120 days for all Life Safety (BLS, ACLS, PALS) certifications expiring in March and April of 2020, as recommended by the American Heart Association (AHA).

Aggression Management

Harris Health is also extending expiration dates by 60 days for Aggression Management (TEAM, SAMA) certifications expiring in March and April 2020.



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Employees who are actively working on expired certifications that meet the extension criteria must present the expired certification, as applicable.
